All RIDERS in BSPS Working Hunter Pony classes and in the Collecting Ring are required to wear a body protector.

Junior competitors MUST have an Adult with them when they are practice jumping in the collecting ring.

No refunds or cancellation of entry fees permitted.

Dogs should be kept on leads at all times.

Horses and Ponies must be attended at all times when tied to the outside of a lorry or trailer.

The organising committee accept no responsibility whatsoever for any loss, injury or damage to any person or their property whilst on the showground, car parks or approaches.

Only horses & ponies entered at the show may be ridden on the show ground.

No lorries or trailers to be cleaned out on the show ground

All B.S.P.S. classes are open to members and non - members of the society

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (B.S.P.S.) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Rules of the B.S.P.S, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.

This Show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S Black Country Saddles Best Rider of the Year. The Best Rider in the Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Lead Rein Hunter Type, Mixed Height Show Pony, Mixed Height SHP, Nursery Stakes, Mixed Height WHP, the Intermediate Show Riding Type and Show Hunter, Working Hunter and Heritage classes will receive a Card and qualify for the final at the B.S.P.S Summer Championships Show.

This Show is a qualifier for the 2023 B.S.P.S. Summer Championships Show, to be held at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincs. The 1st and 2nd prize winners in the appropriate classes will qualify for the B.S.P.S. Championships Show, provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 21 and 26 and ridden by a BSPS member.

Open to mare or gelding four years old and over exceeding 148cms.
- Class H3 Open Riding Horse**
Open to mare or gelding four years old and over exceeding 148cms.
- Class H4 Open Ridden Cob**
Open to mare or gelding four years old and over exceeding 148cms.

Class H8 Working Hunter Pony – Lead Rein

Open to plaited and unplaited ponies, four years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Rider's not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 40cms

Class H9 Working Hunter Pony – Cradle Stakes

Open to plaited and unplaited ponies, four years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Rider's not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 40cms

Class H10 Working Hunter Pony – Nursery Stakes

Open to plaited and unplaited ponies, four years old or over not exceeding 133cms. Rider's not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 50cms.

Class H11 Working Hunter Pony

Open to plaited and unplaited ponies, four years old or over, not exceeding 153cms. Rider's any age but must be suitable for the pony they are riding. Maximum height of fences 60cms.

Class H12 Working Hunter Pony

Open to plaited and unplaited ponies, four years old or over not exceeding 153cms. Rider's any age but must be suitable for the pony they are riding. Maximum height of fences 70cms.

Class H13 Working Hunter Pony

Open to plaited and unplaited ponies, four years old or over not exceeding 153cms. Rider's any age but must be suitable for the pony they are riding. Maximum height of fences 80cms.

Small and Large breeds. Open to stallion, mare or gelding, four years old and over.

Class H16 Style and Appearance – Lead Rein
Open to mare or gelding four years old and over not to exceed 128cms
Riders to be 10 years old and under on the day of the show. To be led by a person 16 years old and over. To be judged 50% Rider 50% Pony
The winner to receive The Hart Cup

Class H17 Young Riders Class
Open to riders 10 years old & under. To be judged on performance only.
Competitors will be asked to walk and trot a figure of eight with a halt at the end of their show off the lead rein.

Class H18 Style and Appearance - 148cms and under
Open to mare or gelding four years old and over.
Ponies to be suitable height for rider. To be judged 50% Rider 50% Pony

Class H19 Style and Appearance – Exceeding 148cms
Open to mare or gelding four years old and over.
Horses to be suitable height for rider. To be judges 50% Rider 50% Horse

Class H20 Ridden Veteran
Open to horses and ponies 16 years old & over

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP – HC 4
1st & 2nd placed in classes H15 – H20 to compete
The Champion to receive The C A HOLBROOK Perpetual Trophy

Open to horses and ponies four years old and over, any type excluding stallions
- Class H23 Young Handler 11 – 16 years old (Age on the day of the show)**
Open to horses and ponies four years old and over, any type excluding stallions
- Class H24 Veteran In Hand**
Open to Horses and Ponies 15 years old and over
This class may be split if sufficient entries

Registered Pure Bred New Forest Connemara, Fells, Dales, Highland, Welsh
Section C & D Ponies four years old or over. Rider's any age.

1st & 2nd placed in classes H27 – H28 to compete

Class H29 B.S.P.S Leading Rein Show Pony
Four years old and over Mare or Gelding - not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant. and shown in snaffle bridles. Lead rein to be attached to noseband only.

Class H30 B.S.P.S First Ridden Show Pony
Four years old and over mare or gelding - not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable Snaffle bridle.

**MINI SHOW PONY CHAMPIONSHIP – HC8
1st & 2nd placed in classes H29 & H30 to compete**

Class H31 B.S.P.S. Mixed Height Open Show Pony
Four years old and over mare or gelding not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before the first of January in the current year. Riders must be the correct height of the pony they ride.

Class H32 B.S.P.S Open Mixed Intermediate Show Hunter/ Show Riding Type
Four years old and over mare or gelding exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year

Class H33 B.S.P.S Mixed Height Open Show Hunter Pony
Open to mare or gelding four years old and over not exceeding 153cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of the animal they are riding.
